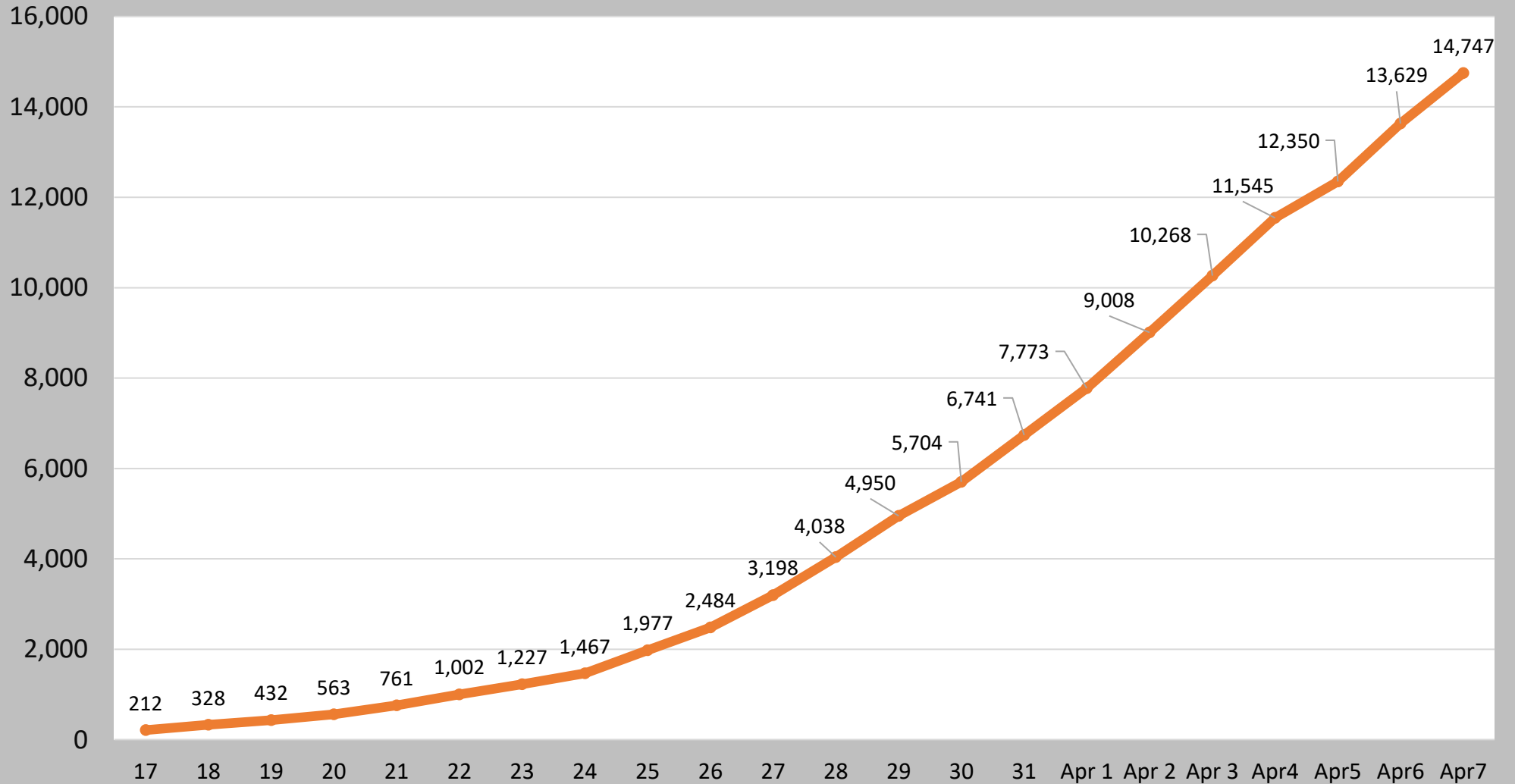

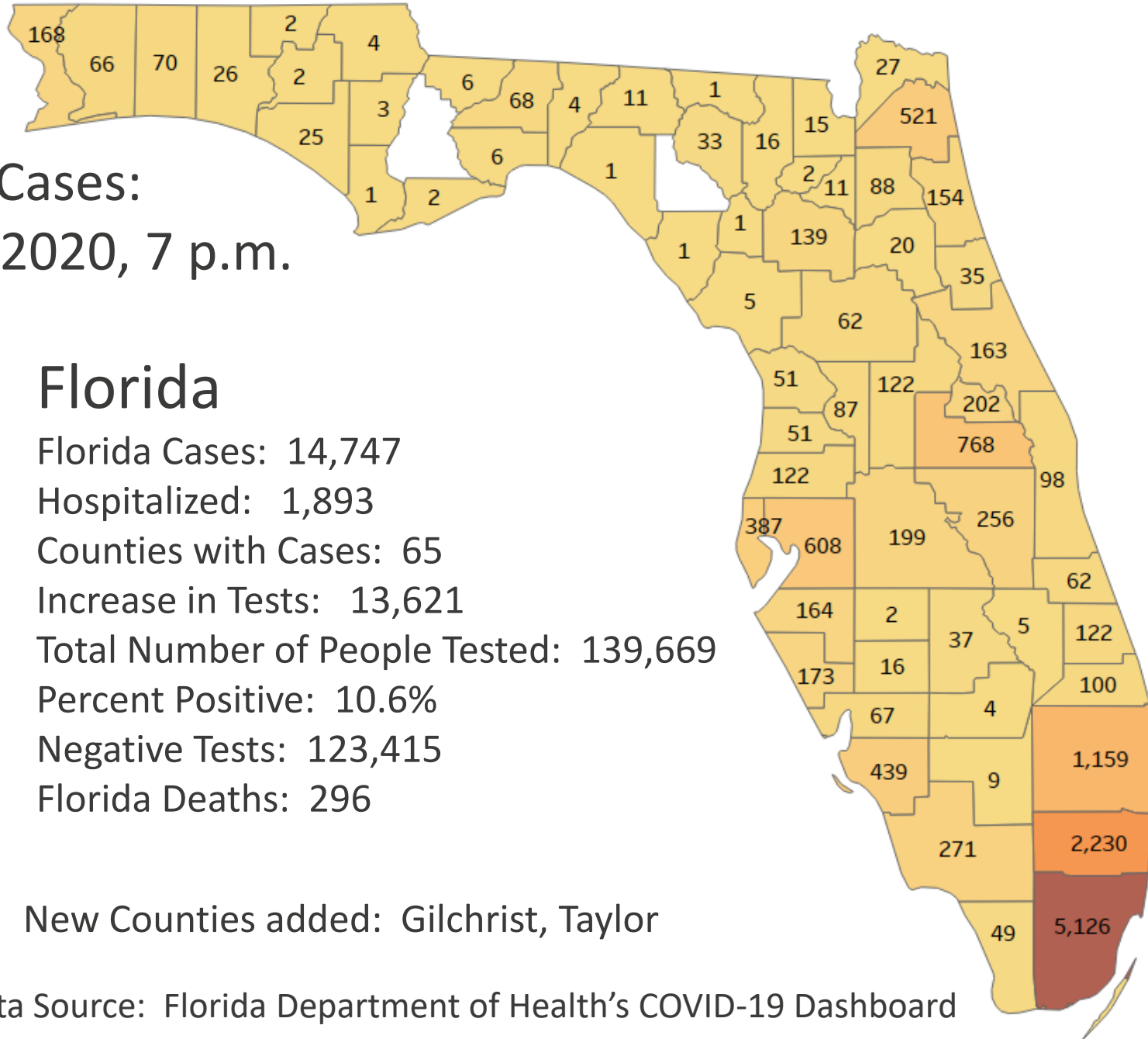

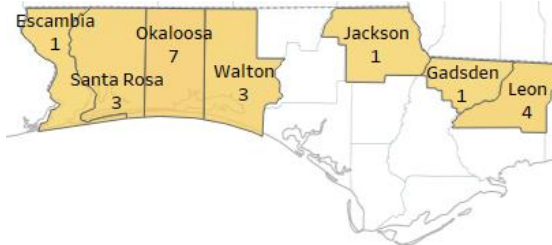

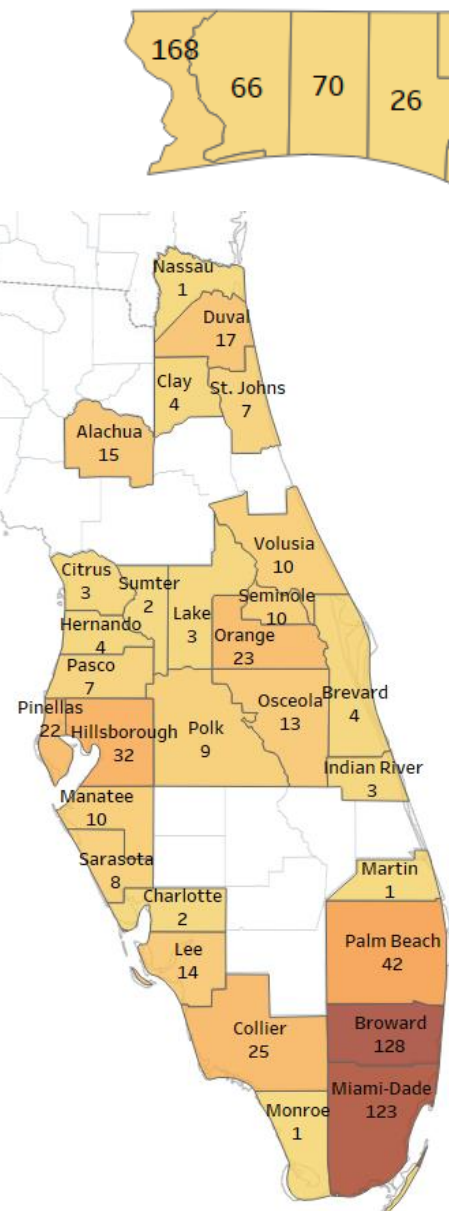

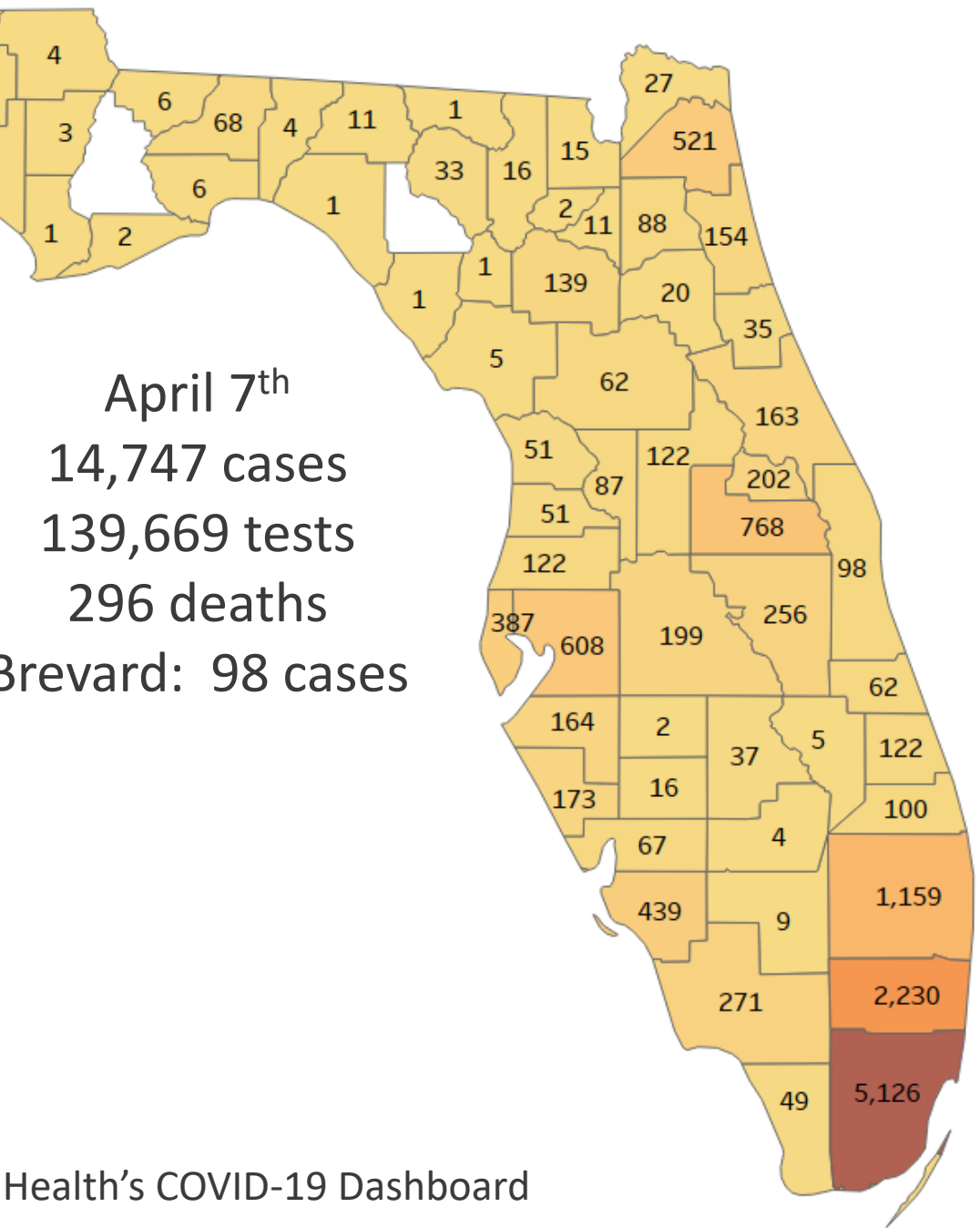

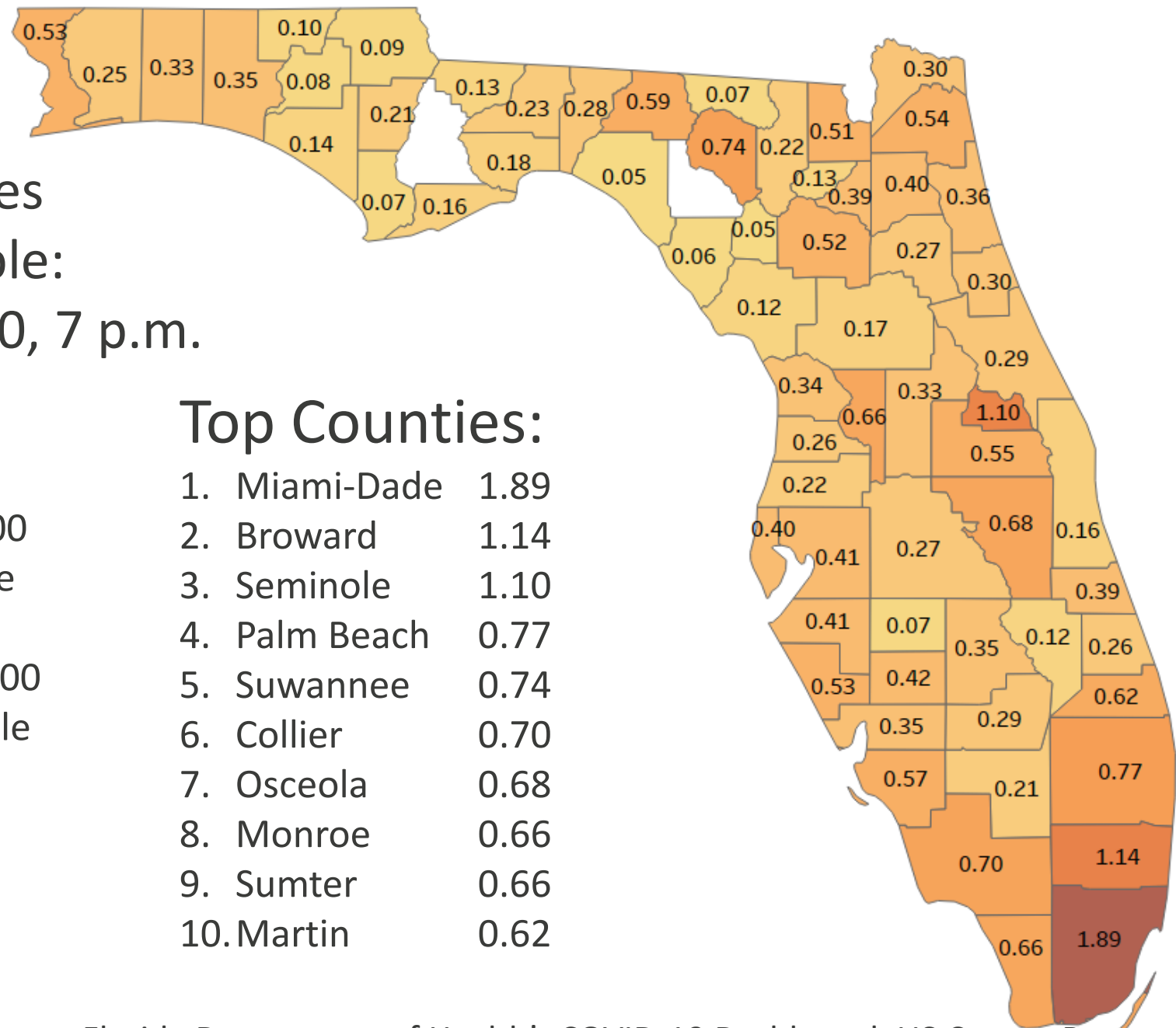

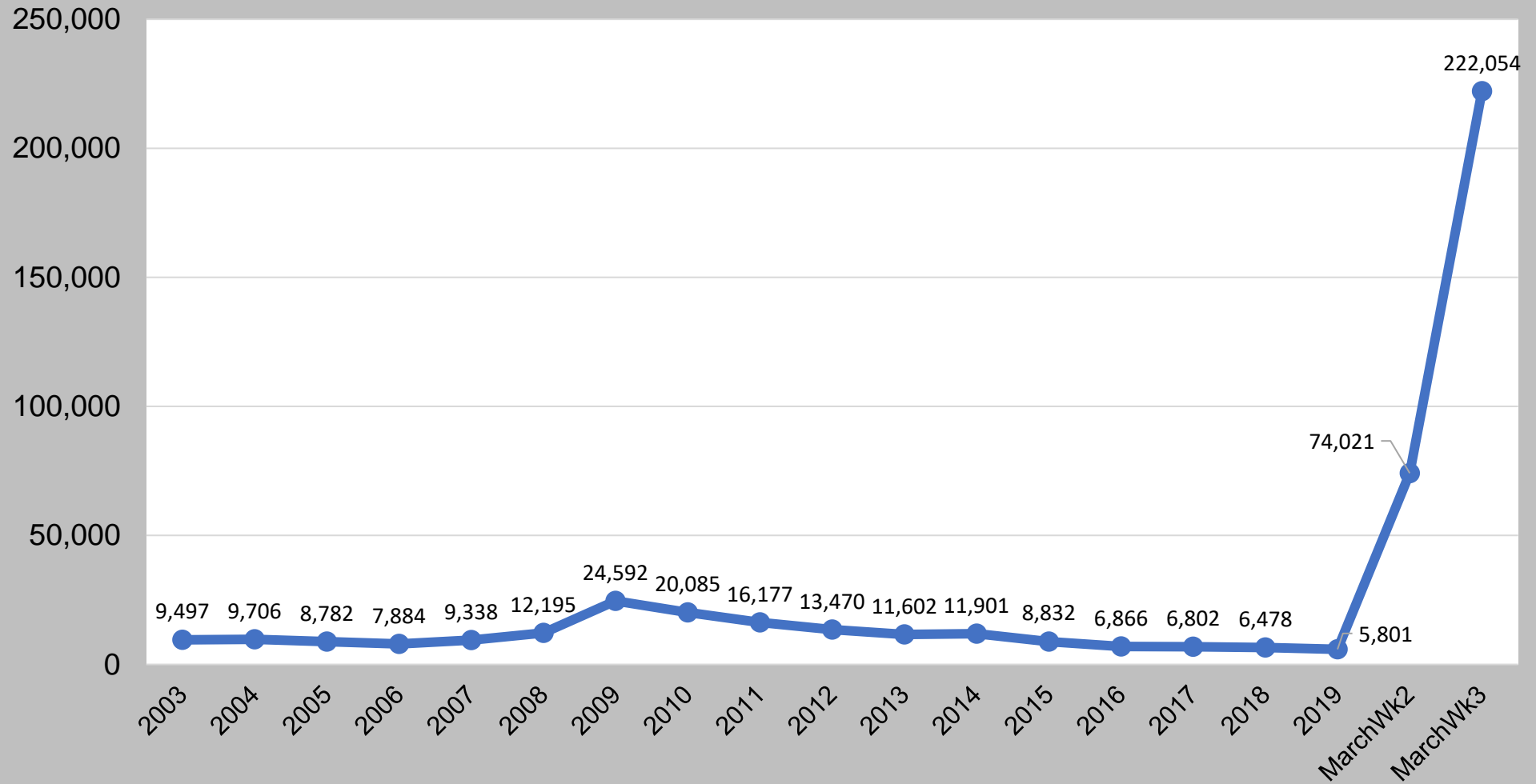

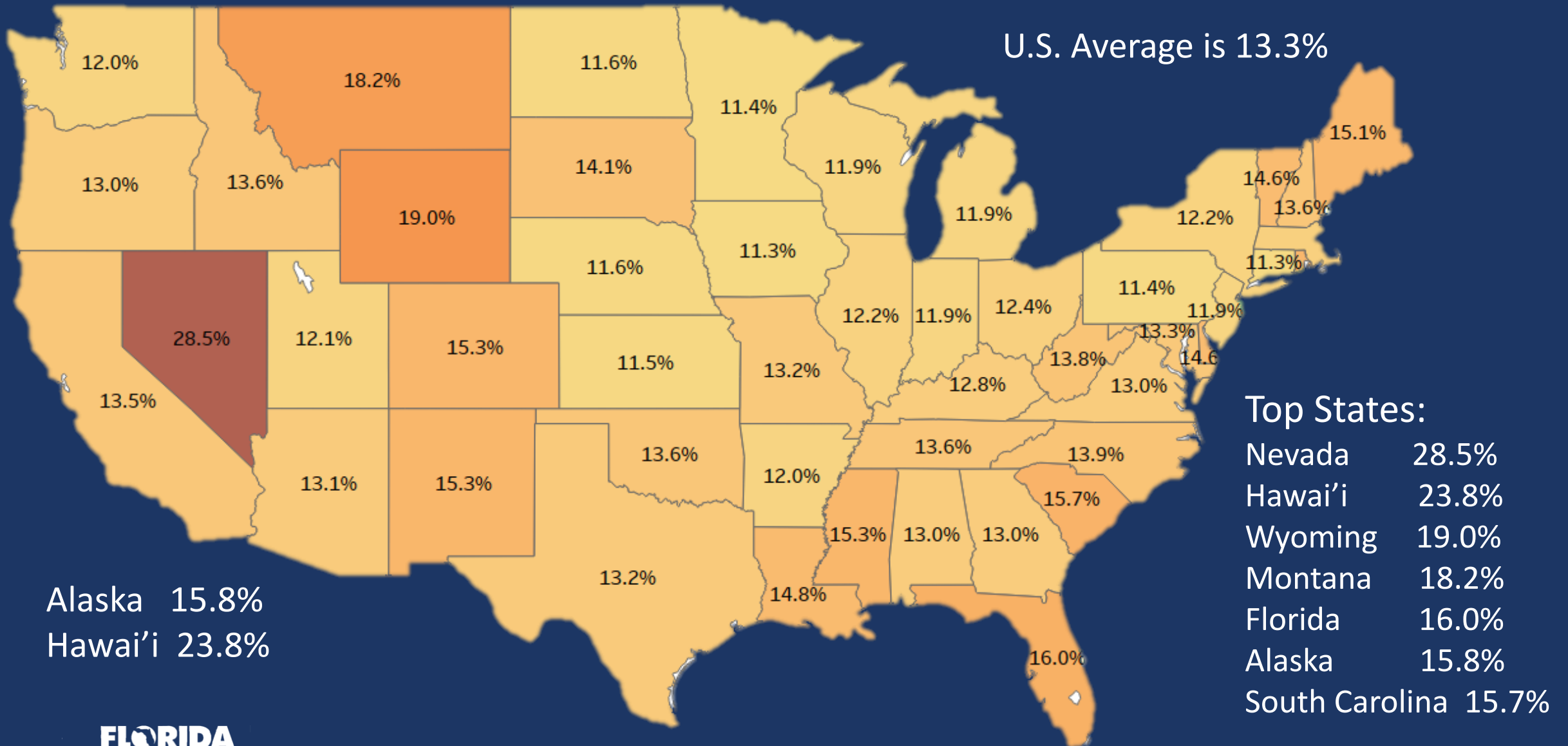

Leisure & Hospitality Jobs as a Percent of Total Private Jobs

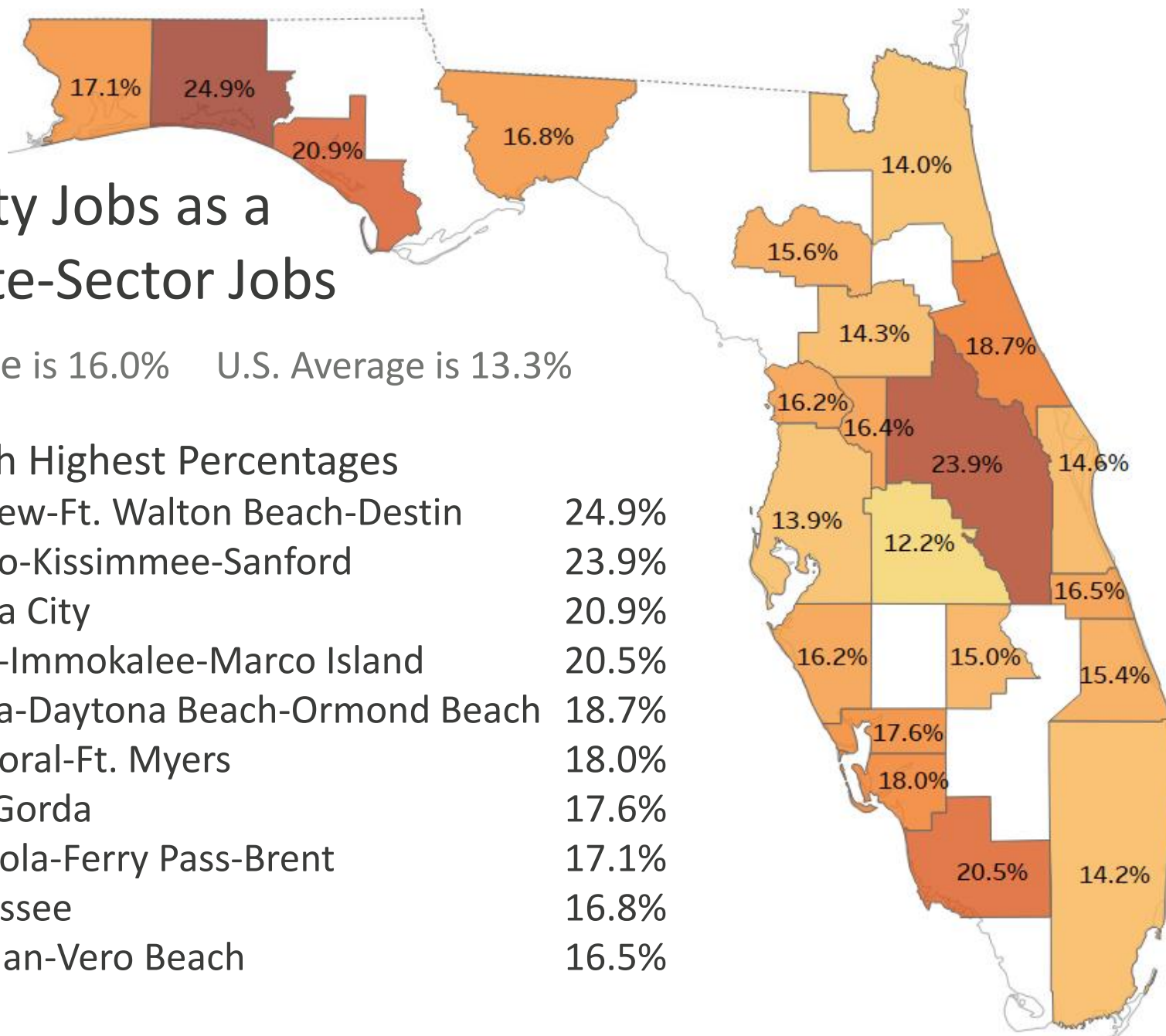

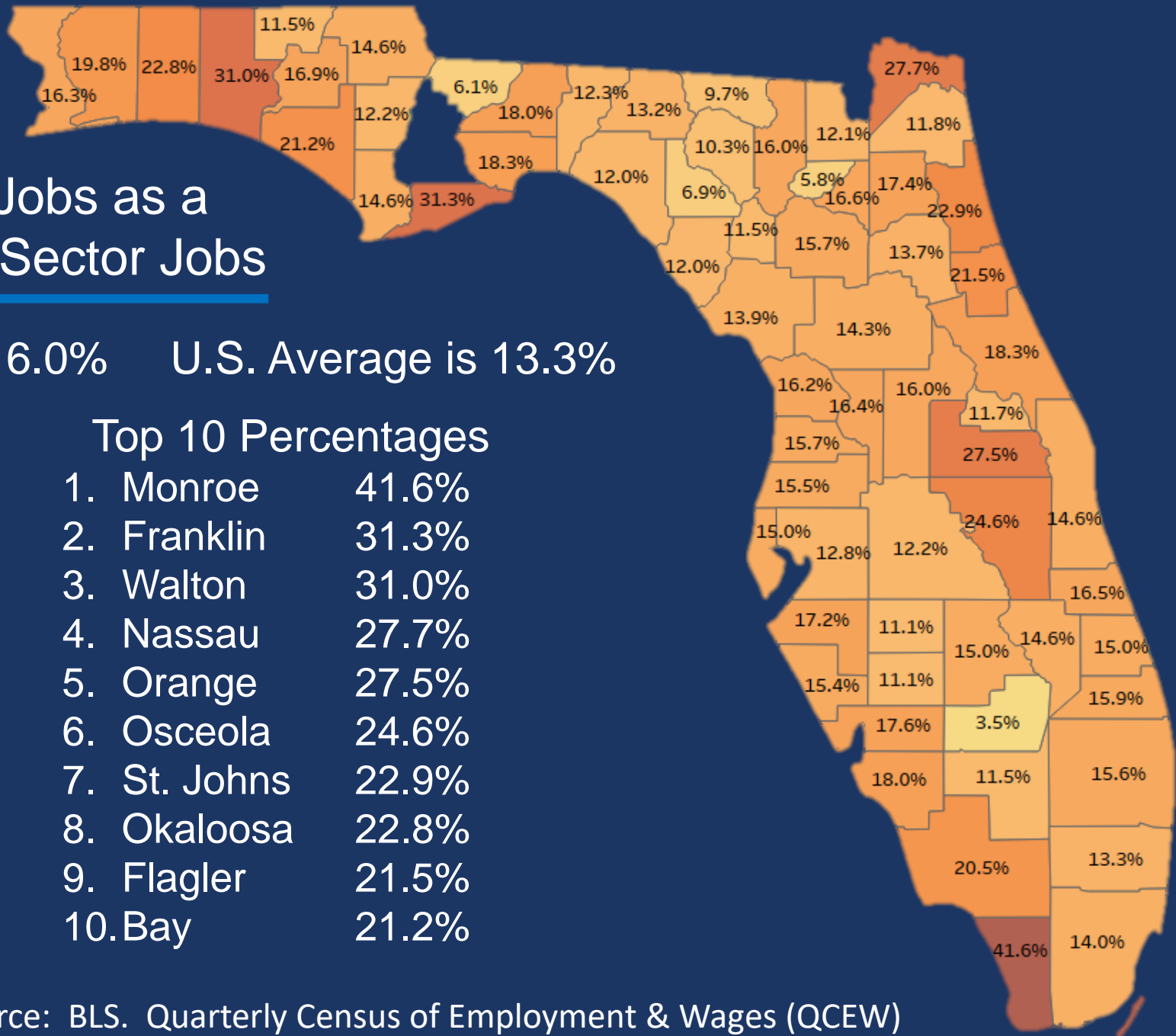
